In exceptional cases where the employer partially pays the fee, the school board can decide to reduce the fee

Annual school fees

The school activities are financed through both government grants and student fees. The pre-school is solely financed through student fees.

The following is included in the fee: educational materials, lunch cooked at the school, fruit mid-morning (only school), snack in the afternoon, after school, school camp (one each semester, only for school children).

Reduced fee for siblings

Applications submitted to the board can yield reduced fee for siblings:

- 3rd (youngest) sibling 10 %
- 4th (youngest) sibling 15%
- more siblings (youngest) 15 %

Supervision for secondary/high school students

Supervision is financed through both government grants and student fees. School books, computers and other materials are not included in the fee.

Students without government grants

- Distance learning with guidance 6h/week with lunch SEK 50000
- Students with government grants
- Distance learning with guidance 6h/week with lunch SEK 34300

Guided leisure time for Scandinavian children not attending the Scandinavian school

Our leisure activities are open for Scandinavian children aged four years and above, who do not attend the Scandinavian school.

Monday-Thursday 2.15 - 5.00 pm

This includes educator guided activities, free access to toys and other play materials, facilities, pool, tennis court, fruit and water and free to take part in afternoon activities.

Fee is 2500 SEK/month. The fee can be paid monthly or on a per semester basis.
Applications made to the school administration.



Evening activities

850 SEK per semester per child

Free for children of the teachers and students with reduced fee.

Guest students

Guest students, short term visit, up to 8 weeks:

Kindergarten 1-5 years SEK 1700/week

School 6-16 years: SEK 3000/week

Additional education (Norwegian/Swedish/Danish)

Additional education in the Scandinavian languages for students from other schools (depending on teaching resources). Application made to the principal:

SEK 6000/semester, 60 minutes/week. If a student starts in the middle of a semester, we charge SEK 600/week, 60 minutes hour.

Education in the Scandinavian languages for adults

The school offers education in the Scandinavian languages for adults, depending on teaching resources. Applications made to the principal:

SEK 6000/semester 60 minutes/week. If a student starts in the middle of a semester, we charge SEK 600/week and 60 minutes.

Terms of payment

- The annual school fee is to be paid in three parts; 20% before the start of the fall semester, 40% at the start of the fall semester and 40% before the start of the spring semester.
- Students/kindergarten children starting after the start of the semester but before 1st of October or 1st of March pay full semester fee.
- Students/kindergarten children starting after 1st of October or 1st of March pay a reduced fee.
- Students starting at spring semester pay 60% of school year fee.
- Kindergarten children starting at the spring semester pay 50 % of school year fee.
- Students/kindergarten children leaving the school during semesters pay full fee. Exceptions will only be made if the school is informed of the departure, in writing, before the start of the semester.
- Students/kindergarten children leaving after 1st of May or 1st of December will get no reduction of fee.
- The full invoice amount must be at the schools disposal no later than the payment date stated on the invoice. Payment must be made in metical to the school's metical account. The school board sets the exchange rate on the 1st of June and 1st of December. A reminder fee of 10% will be charged in the event of an outstanding payment at the end of the semester. Grades are not awarded without full payment and payments from the previous semester must be made before the student may start the next semester.
- Invoices should be sent out at least 30 days before the due date.
- The principal can grant a monthly payment. The monthly fee is based on the exchange rate set by the Board at the beginning of the semester.

Scholarships

Swedish students at schools abroad can apply for scholarships from Utrikeshandelsföreningens Stipendiefond för svensk utlandsungdom.
